

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 383

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 383 will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, April 6, 2022, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, Pecos Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Development in the District and elsewhere in Gleannloch Farms.
 - c. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections and payment of tax bills.
 - d. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.

 - v. conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
 - g. Engineering matters, including:
 - i. deeds, easements, execution of plats, consents to encroachment requests for annexation and/or service, utility commitment letters, and wastewater service contracts;
 - ii. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance and direct engineer to notify insurance company of acceptance, as appropriate, for Water Plant 1 and 2 Rehabilitation Project;
 - iii. Water Plant 1 and 2 Tank Recoating Project;
 - iv. update on application for renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit; and
 - v. review Emergency Preparedness Plan and authorize filing of updates, if necessary.

- h. Channel and pond maintenance, including detention and drainage facilities report and proposals for work.
 - i. District website and communication matters.
