

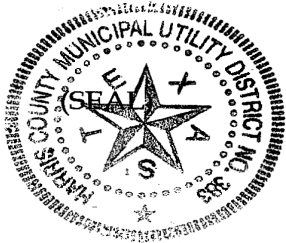
NOTICE OF MEETING


HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 383

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 383 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, January 4, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, Pecos Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Development in the District and elsewhere in Gleannloch Farms.
 - c. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections and payment of tax bills.
 - d. Annual Report regarding Post-Issuance Compliance Policy.
 - e. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - i. payment of bills, review of investments, and budget comparison; and
 - ii. accept annual disclosure statements for Investment Officer and bookkeeper.
 - f. Garbage and recycling matters.
 - g. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - i. billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and message language on water bills;
 - ii. North Harris County Regional Water Authority matters; and
 - iii. sanitary sewer video inspection program and repairs.
 - h. District park matters, community improvement projects and related coordination with community association.
 - i. Channel and pond maintenance, including detention and drainage facilities report and proposals for work.
 - j. Storm Water Management Plan matters, including proposals for work.
 - k. Review District Information Kit.
 - l. District website and communication matters.
3. NON-CONSENT AGENDA
 - a. Items removed from Consent Agenda.
 - b. Engineering matters, including:
 - i. authorize design of District facilities;
 - ii. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction projects, including:

- aa. gravity sanitary sewer line for restrooms at the recreation center;
 - bb. waterline loop; and
 - cc. third water well;
- iii. review bids and award contracts;
- iv. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate, for construction projects;
- v. update on application for renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit;
- vi. deeds, easements, execution of plats, consents to encroachment requests for annexation and/or service, utility commitment letters, and wastewater service contracts;
- vii. capital improvement plan, including project funding;
- viii. update on District drainage matters and, if appropriate, authorize District engineer to conduct drainage study; and
- ix. other engineering matters.
- c. Additional tax matters.
- d. Additional financial and bookkeeping matters, including amend District budget for fiscal year end March 31, 2023.
- e. Receive and review update on 10-year budget forecast and take appropriate action.
- f. Additional operating matters, including:
 - i. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service;
 - ii. discuss the District's Drought Contingency Plan and consider proposal for related signage; and
 - iii. Public Utility Commission rules regarding extreme weather emergencies, including issuance of one-time notice to customers and adopt Amended Rate Order.
